## **Clinic: Building NA, ground floor**

### Basic requirements for this externship:

- Successful clinical rotation at your University
- Additional clinical training in small animal medicine and/or horses
- Speaking the German language is desirable and an advantage
- If you do not speak German, English language is absolutely necessary

### What you need to bring:

- 30 Euro deposit for the locker
- White coat
- Current veterinary anaesthesia text book
- Watch with seconds
- Stethoscope
- for horse clinic: safety shoes

### How your externship at our clinic works:

- Duration is one month to a maximum of two months, depending on availability.
- Registration is at the secretary's office. You will receive your locker keys, logbook, scrubs and name badge.
- On the first day, you will get an anaesthesia logbook. Please fill in accordingly to document the anaesthetic cases that you have performed.
- General working hours are:
  - Monday to Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Extracurricular activities include:
  - Monday at 08.00 a.m.: Journal Club, seminar room, building NA, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor (mandatory) (cancelled once a month for an internal staff meeting – please ask for the current Journal Club dates)
  - Wednesday and Friday from 07.00 to 08:00 a.m.: Continuing education, Seminar room, surgery building, 1<sup>st</sup> floor (mandatory)

### What you gain from this externship:

The main goal of this externship is to familiarize with the basics of balanced anaesthesia, to gain expertise in anaesthesia for special interventions, species, or to practice special techniques.

All external visitors will receive supervision. They may be allowed to carry out some tasks independently according to their on-site performance.

We reserve the right to cancel the externship early if you show a lack of interest and have problems to integrate into the anaesthesia team.
