Basic requirements for the externship:

- Enrolment in a standard or alternative residency program
- Advanced English is required, German is an advantage
- Professional insurance by means of an employment contract is required. If you are not employed you need to take out an insurance for the time of the externship.
- The minimum duration for externships is two weeks, preferably 4 weeks.

What you need to bring:

- 30,00 Euro deposit for the locker (will be returned)
- White coat
- Stethoscope
- Watch with seconds (lapel pin type, no wrist watch, please)
- Current veterinary anesthesia text book
- Passport or Identity card
- Thermometer, medical scissors (blunt ends for bandages)
- Calculator
- Pen
- Safety shoes (for horse clinic only)

Administration/Practical information:

- Registration is at the office on your first day. You will receive:
 - Chip for locker
 - Scrubs
 - Name badge

- General working hours are:
 - Monday to Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

- Extracurricular activities include:
 - Monday at 08:00 a.m.: Journal Club (mandatory)
 - Wednesday from 7.00 - 8:00 a.m.: Continuing education (mandatory)
 - Friday 7.00 - 8:00 a.m.: Continuing education (mandatory)

- The anaesthesia team provides a 24/7 on call service for emergencies. It is possible to ask and join the anaesthetists on call. This is especially recommended, if you like to gain more experience in horse anaesthesia.

- Our residency program includes some after-hour educational appointments. We will inform you accordingly during your stay. The appointments are mandatory for ECVAA residents.

What you can gain from the externship:

The goal of the externship will be titrated on the special expectations and needs of your college and residency program, ranging from familiarizing with the basics of balanced anaesthesia, to gaining expertise in anaesthesia for special interventions, species, or practicing special techniques.

All external visitors will receive supervision. They may be allowed to carry out some tasks independently according to their on-site performance.
